




Number of hours spent on the Internet while in the apartment:




How do you connect to the Internet in your apartment?



How many devices do you typically have connected to the Internet in your apartment?




On a scale of 0-10, how satisfied are you with the speed of your Internet connection in your apartment?




Compared to the school's Internet speeds, is your apartment's connection:




Is your Internet service included in your rent?




Are you more likely to rent in a community that provides Internet access as part of your rent?




Would you be willing to pay a separate monthly fee for additional bandwidth speeds in your apartment?




How much of a monthly increase would you consider if your Internet speed increased by 50%?




Would you consider relocating if your apartment's Internet speeds were slower than expected?




How would you rank the following apartment amenities in order of importance to you? (1 – Most Important, 6 – Least Important)












Do you feel like you have more or less access to technology compared to living at home?
